

Pre-congress Workshop Gynaecological Ultrasound for Minimal Access Surgery

Objectives

- 1. To understand how advanced ultrasound techniques can transform a minimal access gynaecological service.
- 2. To develop an understanding of recent progress in advanced ultrasound techniques as applied to the common diseases treated by minimal access surgeons.
- 3. To gain an understanding of the research evidence base for the use of ultrasound in gynaecology

Description

This workshop will provide lectures and case studies applicable to all the major diseases encountered in everyday minimal access gynaecological practice.

The course will cover both elective and emergency cases and scenarios.

The course will be broken up into 4 sections covering: general technique and theory; uterine pathology; adnexal pathology including ectopic pregnancy; endometriosis including, bowel, urinary tract and superficial endometriosis diagnosis.

Lectures will be given by leaders in their field who all have an detailed understanding of both minimal access surgery and the use of ultrasound to enhance patient care.
